Direct Access Mobilization Module

The old Mobilization Readiness Tracking Tool (MRTT) was decommissioned on June 1, 2017 as announced in ALCGPSC 052/17. The transition from MRTT into the new Mobilization function within Direct Access brings the volunteer/mobilization and orders issuing processes into a single data system.

Those interested in volunteering to fill any existing or future response/recovery requirements must submit their request (with command endorsement) through Direct Access in order for Surge Staffing to consider you for orders.
