Incumbent is the External Affairs Specialist and plays a major role in the study, review, development and adjustment of the strategies, concepts, programs and budgets required to support U.S. Coast Guard International policy and program planning guidance in the Pacific Theater; independently identifies and focuses senior policy attention on international issues with major Coast Guard, Department of Homeland Security, or international security implications.
