Off-Season Extended Active Duty Opportunity Solicitations

The CG Office of Personnel Management (PSC-opm) is seeking Reserve or Active Component Officers to support two critical fill positions at Headquarters. Members interested in these opportunities are encouraged to reach out to the below points of contacts for the applicable position immediately.

The Personnel Service Center Business Operations (PSC BOPS) office is looking for a junior officer to lead the Official Military Personnel File – Implementation team to implement the new Interactive Personnel Electronics Records Management System (IPERMS). The member selected for this position will be responsible for launching this system, allowing all CG military members to access their military records from a CG workstation or their mobile device, eliminating the need to request an EI-PDR to verify their record prior to boards and panels.

CG-7D is looking for an O-3 with strong project management skills to coordinate a six person core team consisting of experts in Human Performance Technology. The team will analyze nine of the CGs enlisted "technical" ratings, doing cross comparisons and looking for redundancies. They will then analyze the work currently being done with an emphasis on the CGs newest acquisitions. Finally they will make recommendations to Senior Leadership on the optimal future workforce structure.

The team will be working along with an ad hoc team of representatives from 25 other programs and offices throughout headquarters and will regularly brief the Senior Guidance team. The initial project should conclude July 2022 with a follow on implementation period.
